Other requirements: Requires a valid driver's license, ability to communicate effectively in English and Hmong. Individuals from other Asian/Refugee ethnic background will also be considered.

Job Duties: The position will provide clinical services in the area of mental health. Clientele population includes refugee (Hmong, Burmese), as well clients for the general population. Clinical work will be provided in-office, in-home, and tele-health. Candidate must be receptive to doing in-home therapy when needed. Supervision will be provided as appropriate.

1. Conduct mental health assessments using DSM V
2. Conduct intake and treatment plans
3. Provide individual psychotherapy to children and adults (outpatient and in-home)
4. Complete discharge planning and follow-up care
5. Maintain confidential notes and records
6. Collaborate with psychiatrist for medication management

Skills & Qualifications: A licensed therapist is preferred but ASPW certified or individuals with training certificate, with intent to complete their 3,000 hrs and work toward licensing will also be considered. Prior experiences with Hmong or refugee clients preferred but not required.

To qualify for the position, the candidate must be bilingual in English and Hmong or of another Asian/refugee ethnic background (Laos, Thai, Chinese, etc.). This will be a part-time to full-time position with flexible hours. Actual hours are base on caseload, funding, and collaboration opportunities with other agencies. Strong organization skills, professionalism, strong ethics, and ability to work with diverse clienteles is preferred.
